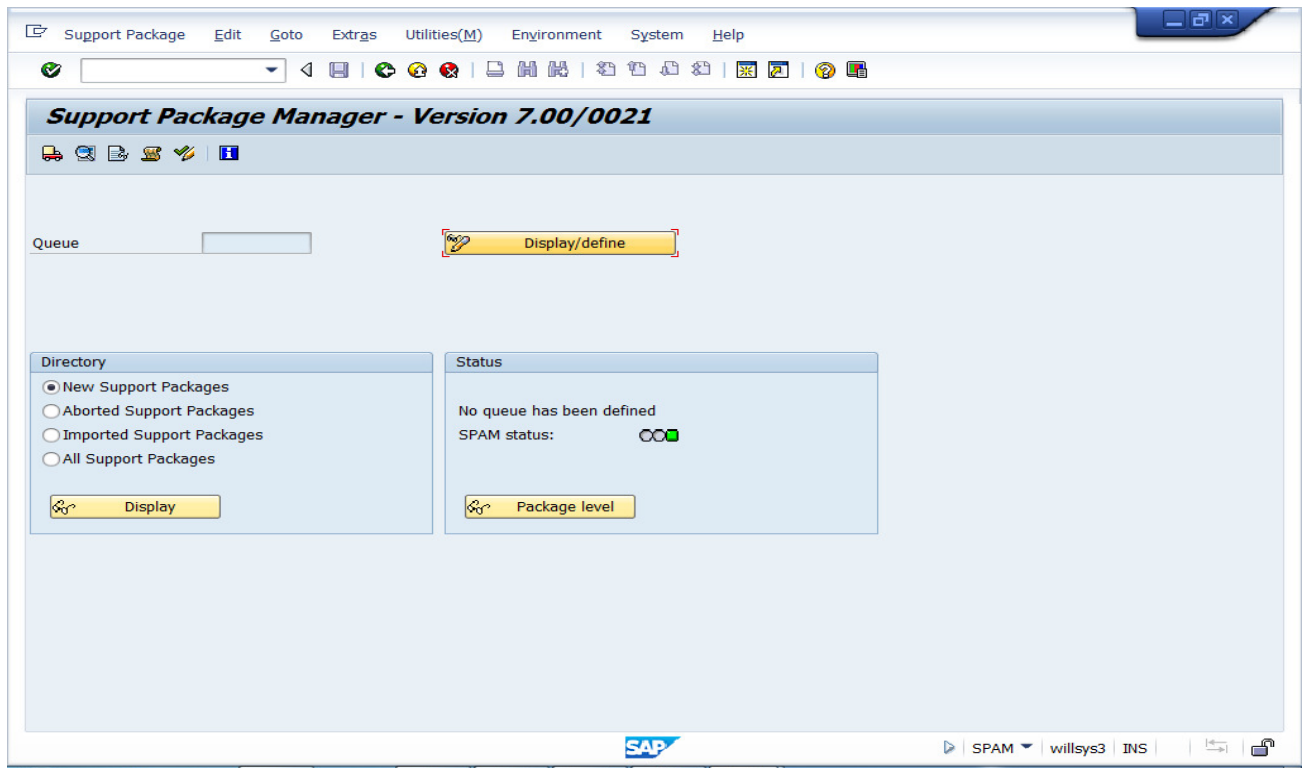

SPAM/SAINT TOOL UPDATE

1. SPAM/SAINT Tool are applied only through client 000 with user like ddic
2. Ensure that STMS is configured in client 000.
3. Ensure that TP, R3Trans, SAP CAR are upgraded to the latest version.
4. Ensure that 2 free back ground process (work) are available (at least).
5. Ensure that you have enough space in the database. Execute DB02 to check the size of each tables space and ensure that each one below 90% or (click on critical space objects).
6. Ensure that we have enough space in usr/sap/trans directory.
7. Ensure that RDDIMPDP, RDDNEWPP background jobs are scheduled in 000 client to SPAM/SAINT Tool. (Execute SA38 -> specify job name and execute jobs).
8. Check SPAM/SAINT Tool Current Version.
Execute SPAM T-Code.



STEP 1:

- Copy the SPAM/SAINT Tool into trans directory using 'cp -pr kd70038.sar /usr/sap/trans'.

- Give the permission and Ownership for kd70038.sar file.

- Switch to <SID>adm user go to trans directory.

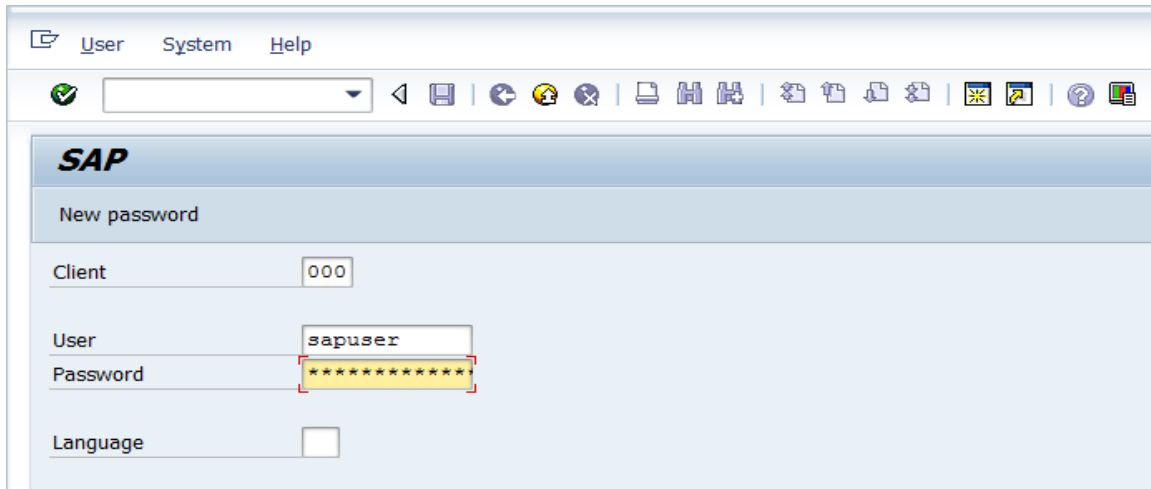
STEP 4:

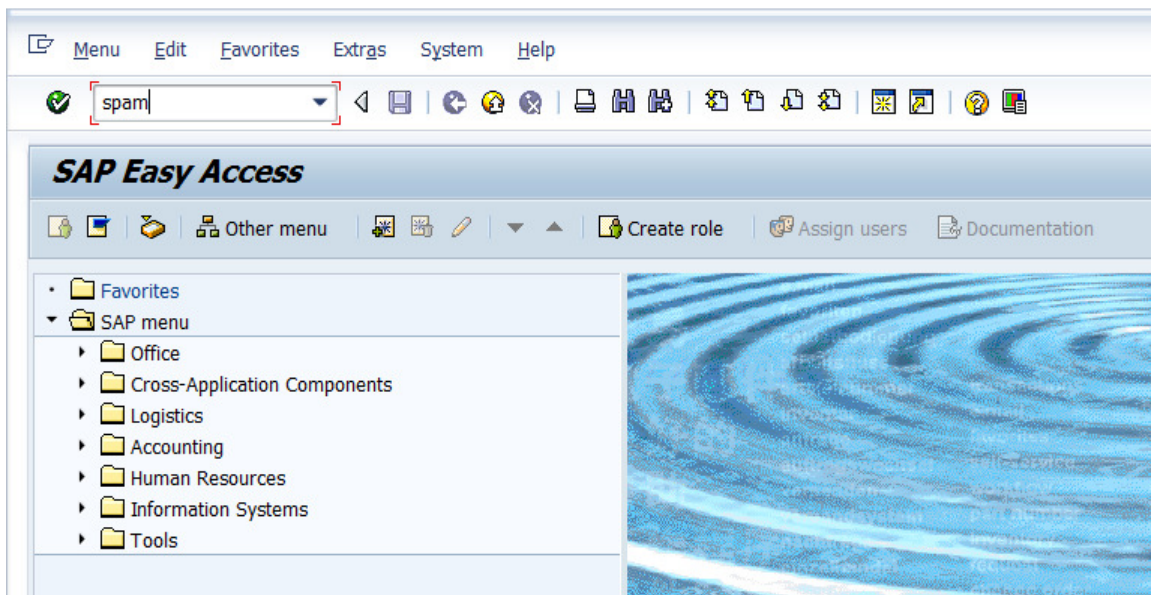
STEP 5:

- Execute SPAM T-Code.

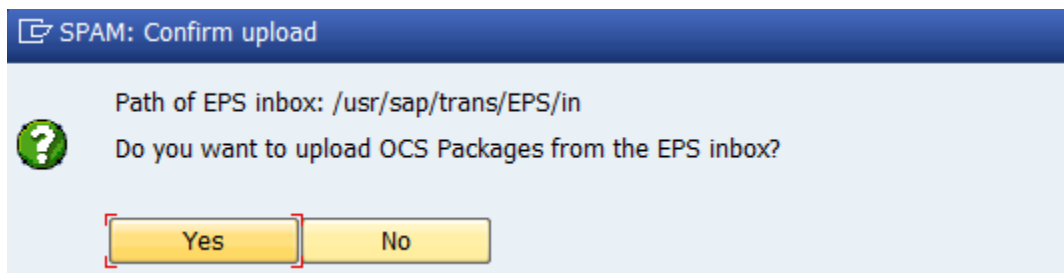
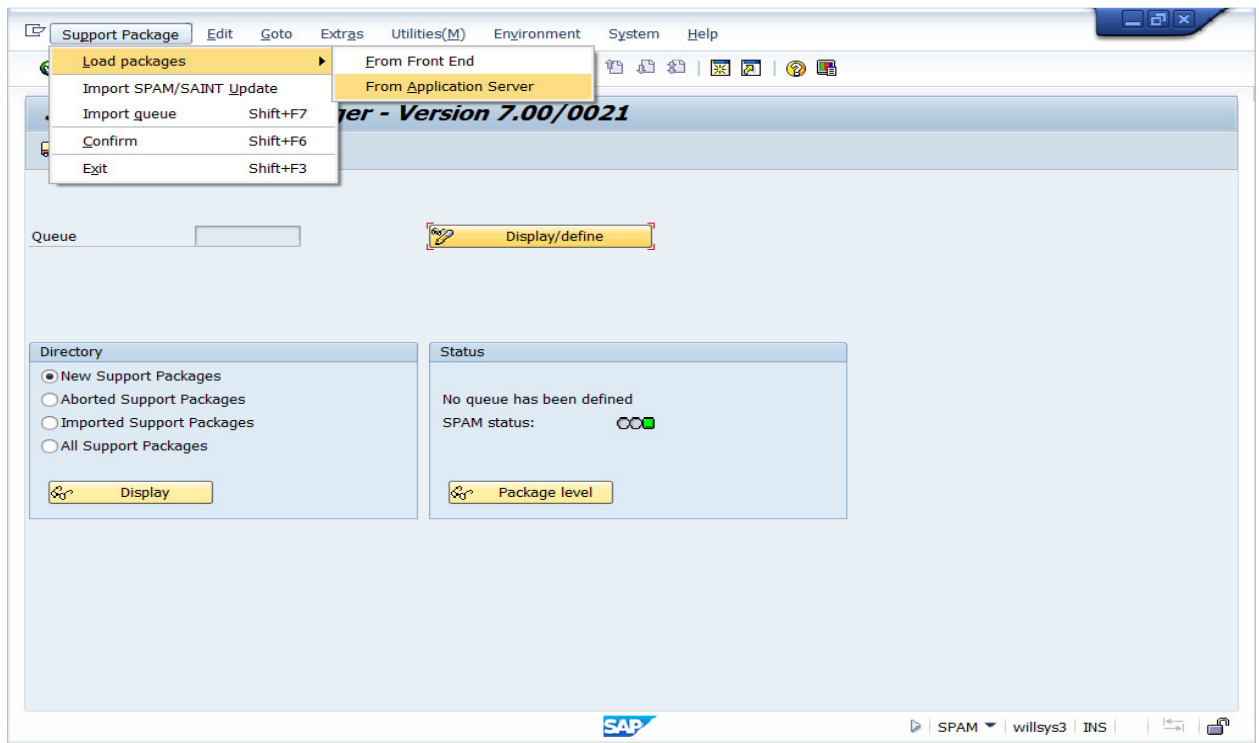


STEP 7:

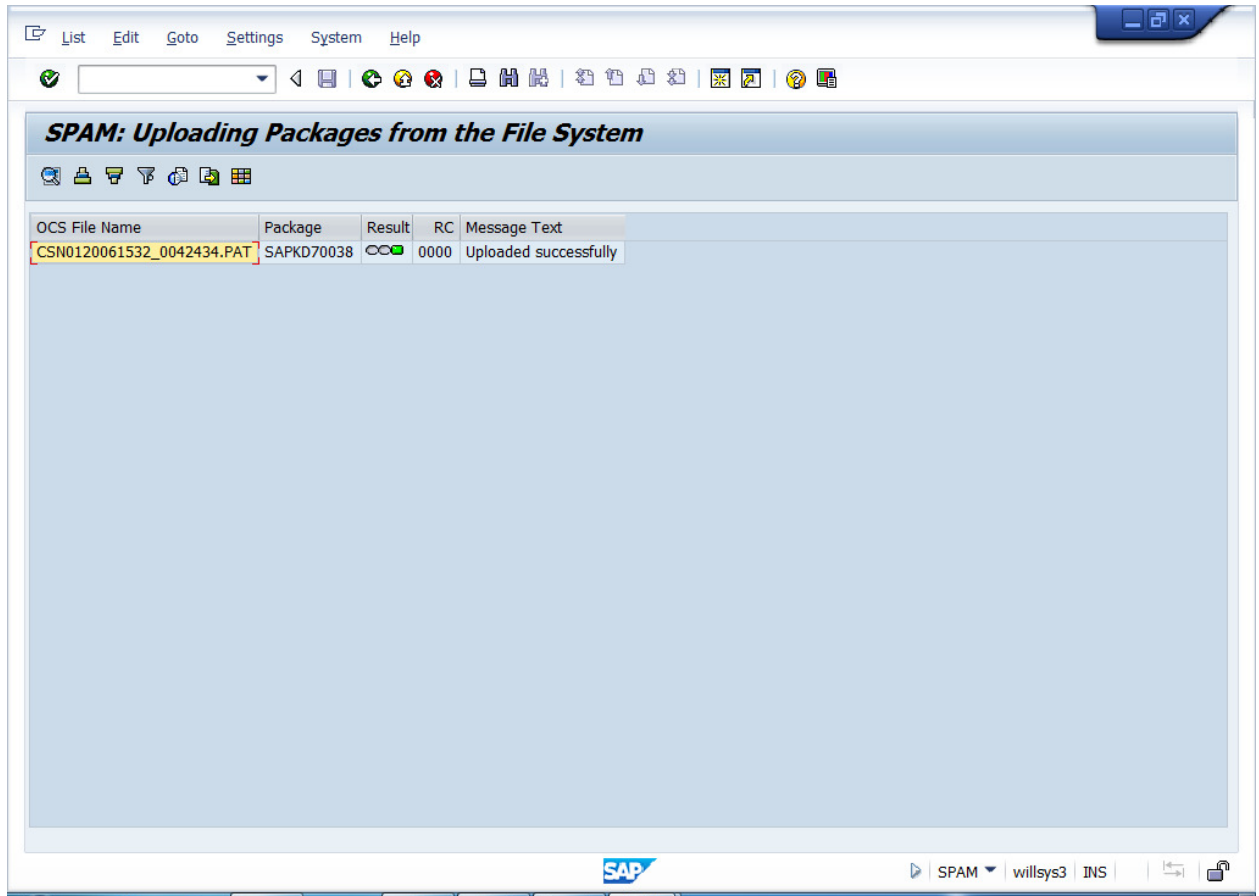
- Go to SUPPORT PACKAGE → LOAD PACKAGES → FROM APPLICATION SERVER

If SPAM/SAINT Tool <10MB use front end.



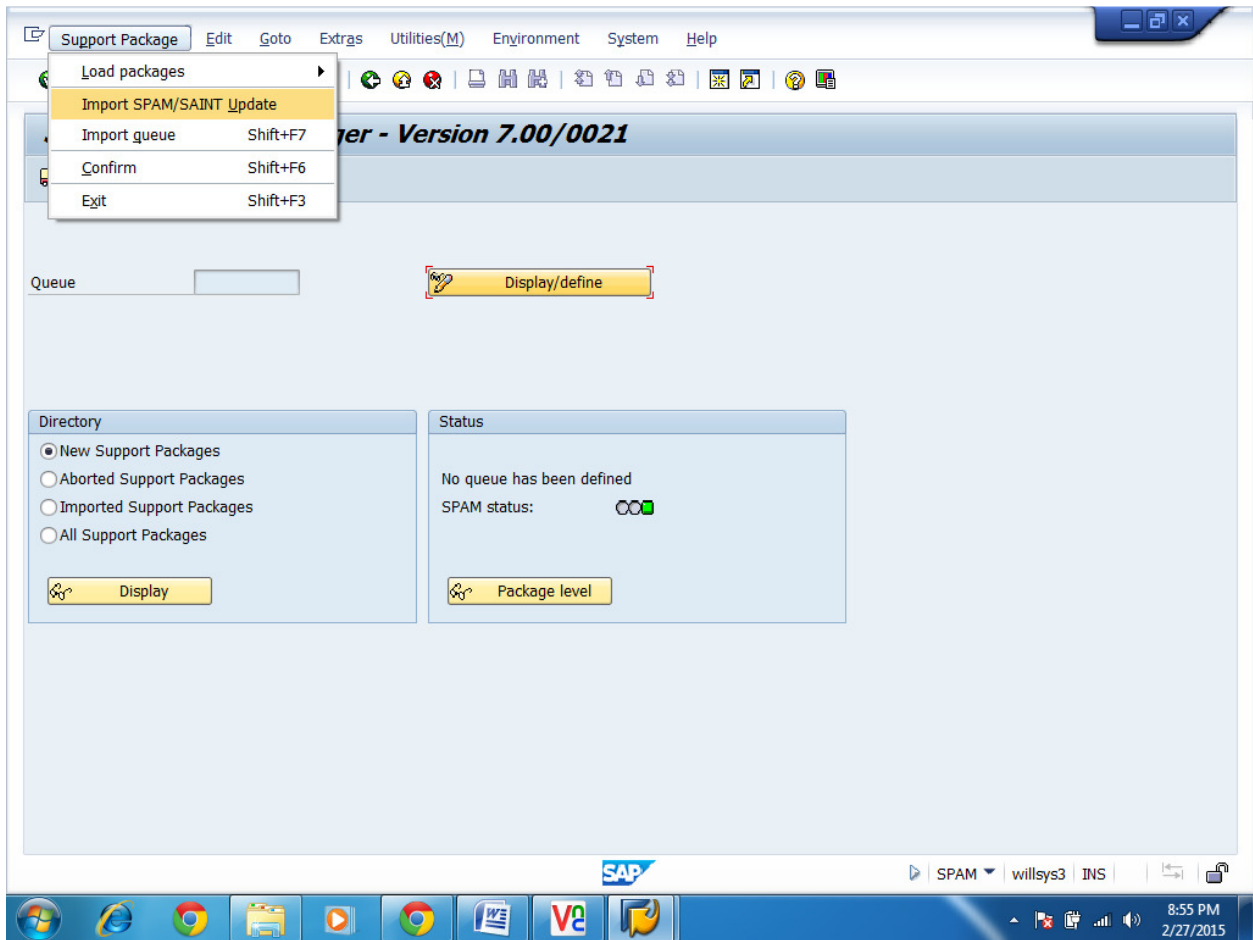
- Uploaded package successfully.



STEP 8:

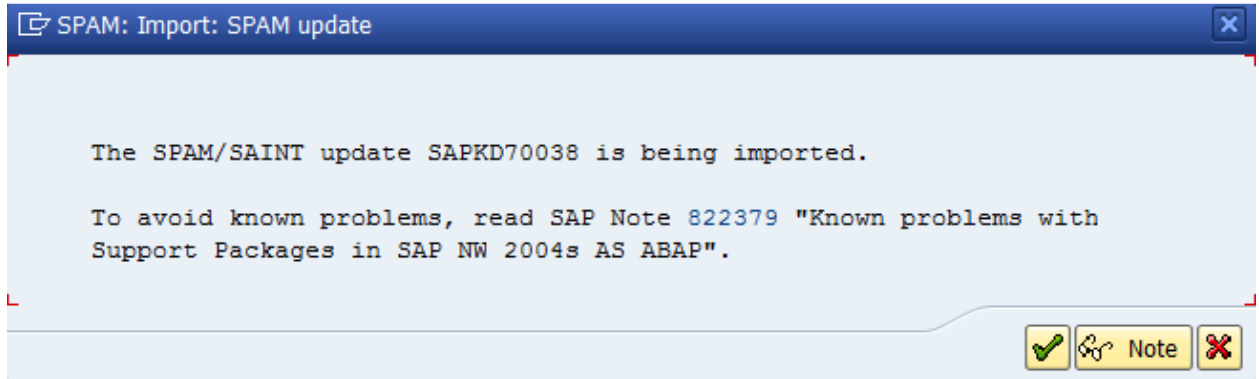
Click IMPORT SPAM/SAINT UPDATE.

Go to SUPPORT PACKAGE → IMPORT SPAM/SAINT UPDATE.



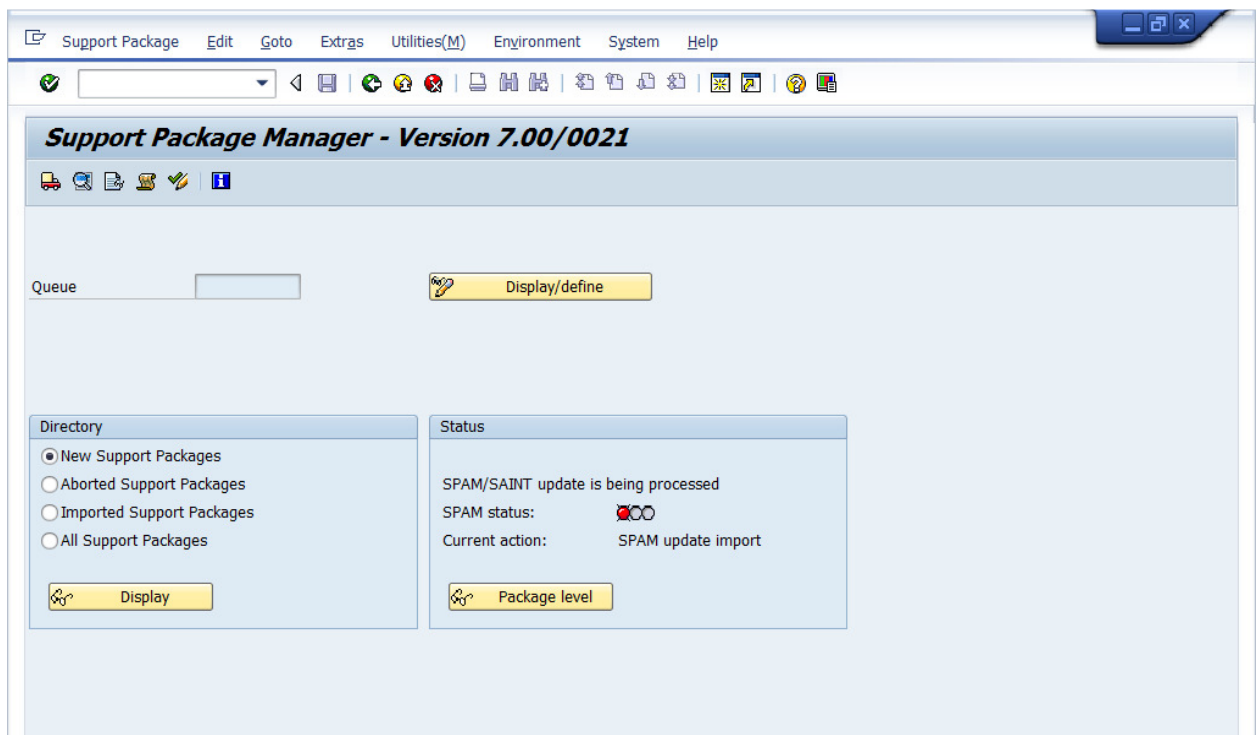
STEP 9:

- Click CONTINUE.



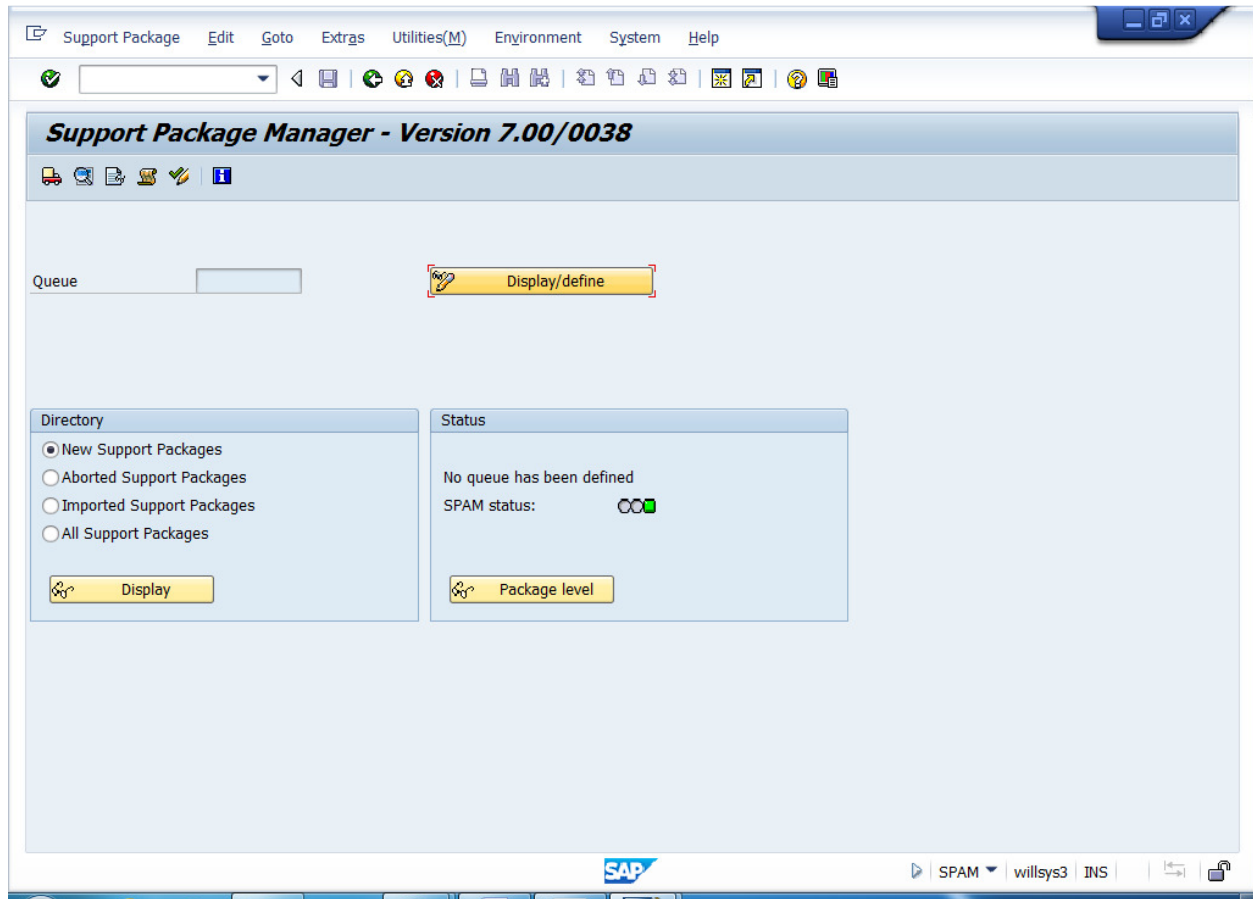
STEP 10:
